Course Overview

Practical placement with families is an essential element of this practical course. Graduates are ready to work as a Nanny and to travel the world working with children in a home or group care situation. Throughout the course, students learn about the responsibilities involved in engaging with groups of children and individuals, working in a team and with family members, how children grow and develop and observing children to learn about their interests and needs.
